MR AMYN HAJI

Consultant in Colorectal and Laparoscopic Surgeon King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

Mr Amyn Haji was appointed as a Consultant in Colorectal and Laparoscopic Surgery at King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust in 2011 and is currently the Clinical Lead for Endoscopy and Colorectal Surgery.

His clinical practice primarily consists of laparoscopic colorectal surgery, advanced colonoscopy and laparoscopic hernia surgery. Mr Haji graduated from the University of Cambridge in 1999 where he was awarded a Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery degree and a Master of Arts. Mr Haji was admitted as a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England in February 2010 and received his certificate of completion of training (CCT) in March 2011.

His research and clinical interests are in utilisation of high frequency colonoscopy ultrasound in the staging of colorectal polyps and cancer. He completed a fellowship in advanced colonoscopy with Professor Kudo at Showa University in Japan in 2010 and since then has developed a practice of endoscopic mucosal resection and endoscopic submucosal dissection in the treatment of colorectal polyps and advanced endoscopy techniques. He also introduced Peroral endoscopic myotomy for Achalasia to the United Kingdom I 2013 and is the leading expert in this field in the UK

PROF BU' HUSSAIN HAYEE

Consultant Gastroenterologist King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

Dr Hayee is a Consultant Gastroenterologist at King's College Hospital and has been Clinical Lead for the department since 2015. He trained at Guy's Hospital (GKT Medical School), graduating in 1999, and was appointed a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians in 2015. His PhD, awarded in 2010, examined the role of innate immunity and neutrophil function in Crohn's disease.

He is a Reader in Gastroenterology at King's College London and maintains an active research interest, supervising several PhD fellows and basic scientists.

He is nationally-accredited for bowel cancer screening colonoscopy and has specialist interests in Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) and high-quality endoscopy. He is training lead for Endoscopy at King's and led development of the specialist IBD service from 2012-2017, being shortlisted for an HSJ Excellence in Healthcare award in 2017. In 2011, he was awarded a travelling fellowship to Yokohama, Japan to study advanced endoscopic techniques with ProfessorsHaruhirolnoue and Shin-eiKudo and is co-director of the King's Institute of Therapeutic Endoscopy





DR DEEPAK JOSHI

Consultant Hepatologist King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

Dr Deepak Joshi is a leading consultant hepatologist in London, who specialises in liver disease, liver transplant and cirrhosis. After qualifying in medicine at King's College in 2001 he went on to train in hepatology at the Institute of Liver Studies, where he carried out a PhD researching into predictors of fibrosis in patients following a liver transplant. He further honed his skills in endoscopy and ERCP, training at the reputable University College London Hospitals.

An active researcher in the hepatology field, he has published extensively in peer-reviewed papers, contributed to book chapters, and co-authored Hepatology at a Glance. His main clinical interests include biliary disease, as well as treatment and management of all kinds of conditions to do with the liver or pancreas. At present, he works as consultant hepatologist at the Guthrie Clinic, and consultant hepatologist at the Institute of Liver Studies, King's College Hospital




PROF CESARE HASSAN

Italy

Cesare Hassan, MD, PhD, graduated in Medicine and Surgery in 1994, and he became a specialist in Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy at 'Sapienza University' in Rome in 1998.

His clinical and research turned mainly to the development of new approach for colorectal cancer screening, mainly focusing on clinical validation, cost-effectiveness and decision-making, as well as for prevention of upper Gl-cancer, including endoscopic and medical treatment of pre-malignant gastric conditions and Barrett oesophagus. To date, his work has resulted in over 500 peer-reviewed publications, and is regularly invited to present at major national and international meetings.

Dr. Hassan is currently the President of the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, where he also served as Chair of the Guideline Committee, and he is Full Professor of Gastroenterology at Humanitas University (Milan, Italy). His current research focuses on implementation of Artificial Intelligence for detection, characterization, and Quality Improvement of diagnostic endsocopy.





PROF OLIVER PECH

Consultant Gastroenterologist

St. John of God Hospital, Regensburg, Germany

Professor Oliver Pech graduated from the University of Erlangen and started his GI training and training in advanced interventional endoscopy with Professor Christian Ell at HSK Wiesbaden, Germany.

He became a faculty member and Head of Endoscopy at HSK Wiesbaden in 2007. In 2012 Professor Pech became Head of Gastroenterology and Interventional Endoscopy at St. John of God Hospital, Regensburg, Germany – a tertiary teaching hospital and Professor at the University of Regensburg.

Professor Pech is an internationally renowned expert in interventional endoscopy and one of the worldwide leading experts in endoscopic diagnosis and treatment of early Barrett's neoplasia.

He published more than 100 original articles, co-authored several guidelines and is frequently invited as a speaker and as an expert endoscopist on national and international conferences.

Professor Pech was associate editor for the UEG Journal for 6 years and currently is editorial board member at "Endoscopy". Currently his research focus is on endoscopic diagnosis and treatment of early GI neoplasias, artificial intelligence, POEM and endoscopic resection techniques like ESD and EID.

PROF RAF BISSCHOPS

Consultant Gastroenterologist Belgium

Raf Bisschops obtained his Medical Degree in 1997, a PhD degree and certification in gastroenterology in 2005 at the University of Leuven.

He is head of clinic and full professor at the Catholic University of Leuven (KU Leuven), faculty of medicine. He is director of endoscopy since 2013.

His main interest is advanced endoscopic imaging and therapeutics for premalignant conditions (Barrett, HNPCC, colitis), artificial intelligence and quality in endoscopy.

He was co-editor of the journal Endoscopy between 2011 and 2020. He was the president of the Belgian society of Gastrointestinal endoscopy between 2019-2021.

Within the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, he is currently the president elect, and served as secretary general, chairman of the ESGE quality committee and chairman of the ESGE curriculum working group.

Roberta Maselli, MD, PhD, got her degree in Medicine and Surgery and later the specialty in General Surgery at "Sapienza" University of Rome, Italy. She attended a one year theoretical and practical fellowship at the SUITE "Showa University International Training Center for Endoscopy", Northern Yokohama Hospital, Yokohama, Japan under the direction of Professors Haruhiro Inoue and Shin-ei Kudo during which time she achieved the Japanese "Permission of Advanced Clinical Training" for Foreign Medical Practitioner. The fellowship mainly focused on: POEM for esophageal achalasia, Diagnosis (NBI, Magnifying Endoscopy, Endocytoscopy) and endoscopic treatment (EMR,ESD) of GI cancers, SET. Roberta also attended 6 month theoretical and practical Fellowship at the BIDS, "Baldota Institute for Digestive Sciences", Mumbai, India directed by Dr. Amit Maydeo, the focus of which was Therapeutic ERCP and Diagnostic and Therapeutic EUS. She was conferred a PhD on "advanced technologies in surgery" at "Sapienza" University of Rome, Italy in2016.

Since September, 2015 Dr. Maselli has been the Endoscopic Unit of Humanitas Research Hospital, Rozzano, Milan, Italy alongside Prof. Alessandro Repici. Her clinical and research activity is mainly focused on the diagnosis and endoscopic treatment of early GI neoplasia and advanced endoscopic procedures, as well as on the NOTES (Natural Orifice Transluminal Endoscopic Surgery). She is now covering the role of Associate Professor in Gastroenterology in Humanitas University, Milan. Since January 2025 she has been the Chief of Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy of "Humanitas San Pio X Hospital", Milan, Italy.

Roberta has authored more than 200 papers published in recognized international scientific journals. She is member of the Italian Society of Digestive Endoscopy (SIED),, European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE) and American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE). 

Dr Hiroya Sakaguchi is a Consultant Gastroenterologist at Aijinkai Chibune General Hospital in Osaka, Japan, and a Research Fellow at Kobe University Graduate School of Medicine (PhD, 2021). His clinical practice focuses on advanced therapeutic endoscopy, including endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD), peroral endoscopic myotomy (POEM), and comprehensive care for reflux disease and benign oesophageal disorders, integrating high-resolution manometry and impedance–pH monitoring. He also performs anti-reflux mucosectomy (ARMS) as part of his endoscopic management of GERD.

Dr Sakaguchi has performed over 1,000 ESD procedures and more than 100 POEMs, and is actively engaged in training domestic and international endoscopists. He helped establish a multidisciplinary GERD Diagnosis and Treatment Centre at Chibune General Hospital, established in 2025, to bridge state-of-the-art diagnostics with minimally invasive endoscopic therapy.

His research interests include early gastrointestinal cancer detection and treatment, oesophageal motility disorders, reflux phenotyping, and innovation in endoscopic closure and complication prevention. He is a member of the Japan Foregut Society and contributes widely to GERD care through clinical service, education, and collaborative research. He serves as international faculty at major endoscopy meetings and partners with surgical and engineering teams to translate novel techniques into routine practice.

After completing his Masters in General Surgery from Government Medical College and South Gujarat University in Surat, he pursued Advanced Endoscopic Fellowship (1994–1996) under the mentorship of Dr. Amit Maydeo. Dr. Desai pursued a distinguished career marked by innovation, training, and clinical mastery. A Fellow of several prestigious societies—FASGE, FAIGE, FSGEI, FISG, and FJGES—he has played a pivotal role in advancing endoscopic education and therapeutic practice in India and abroad. Dr. Desai has performed more than 1,200 POEMs and other Third-Space procedures, and over 400 ESD/EFTR interventions, along with one of the largest series of ERCP and EUS procedures in Gujarat. As a Teacher and Member of the Asian EUS Group and a Faculty with Olympus and ERBE India, he has mentored numerous gastroenterologists across India, the UK, the USA, and the Middle East, helping establish Third-Space Endoscopy programs in multiple centers. An active academician, Dr. Desai has authored 128 research publications and three textbook chapters. 
